- _____ Key rings free of hanging obstacles / ornaments
- _____ All glass free of cracks
- _____ Functional windshield wipers (only req'd for rain)
- _____ Roll bar / cage is fabricated / installed per SCCA guidelines
- _____ Camera/recording device securely mounted

Brakes

- _____ Brake system is free of leaks
- _____ Brake fluid is clean and reservoir level adequate
- _____ Brake pedal is firm and cannot be pressed to floor
- _____ Pads are adequate thickness
- _____ Rotors are free from cracks and warpage
- _____ Rotors are free from structural rust (no rust pitting / scaling)
